In line with the section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015, this statement sets out the steps taken by Brazen Productions to minimise the potential risk of modern slavery in its business or supply chains. Brazen is committed to the principles of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and the abolition of modern slavery and human trafficking. However, we remain vigilant and will continue to review our policies processes, procedures and supply chains to ensure the risk remains low.
